Wyoming County Employability Certificate

*A Demonstration of Desirable
Work Habits*

Incentive to Learn

Wyoming County Business Education Council will issue the certificate of Employability to all high school students who have applied for the program and have met specific eligibility standards in their classroom performance.

Students can benefit by obtaining a Certificate of Employability because it is an endorsement of the students work habits within the classroom. Area employers will have more confidence in students with the certificate because they already demonstrated the desirable work skills, even though they may not have prior work experiences.

Cooperation is the key!

The Wyoming County Employability Certificate is the result of a strong partnership between employers, school districts, parents, students and the community. Mutual commitment and clear expectations will be the key to the success of this program.

The Wyoming County Business Education Council and School Districts are dedicated to establishing and sustaining such standards in alliance with students, educators, parents and employers.

Schools in Wyoming County will each use the same criteria, but have the opportunity to change the format to fit their needs.

Qualifications

*To be eligible for the Certificate of Employability the students **must** meet the following:*

- Parents must sign letter to acknowledge their student is working on this certificate
- No unexcused (unexplainable) absences
- Average no more than one absence per month
- Student must exceed the academic eligibility standard set by the school district, and/or show they are making academic progress.
- Earn an average score of “acceptable” on classroom evaluation. (see categories below)
 - Complete the certificate by the deadline.

Performance Evaluation

Students are evaluated in the following areas:

1. Work habits and attitudes – Demonstrates initiative, flexibility, task completion and efficient time management.
2. Cooperation – Interacts respectfully, works successfully with others, and contributes productively as a team member.
3. Commitment to Quality – Gives best effort, evaluates work, and completes work to quality standards
4. Actively participates and contributes to the learning environment in a consistent and dependable manner.
5. Communication – Applies principals and skills necessary for effective communication in speaking, writing, listening and reading.
