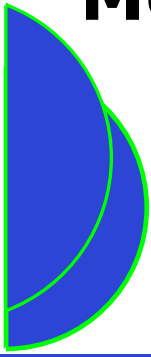

Come experience health professions and explore all of the available career options in the Medical Industry with this interactive camp!

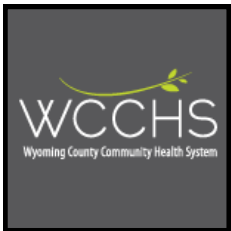
Program Highlights:
